Minutes of the AGM to be held at Exmouth Cricket Club, The Maer on Thursday 12th November 2020

An Agenda was issued, as were the Minutes for the 2019 AGM; the Chairmans, Secretary's and Treasurer's Report and the Certified Accounts for 2019. The proposed Membership fees for 2021-22 were also distributed These documents were either emailed or posted to ALL Club members in line with the Club's Constitution on 15th October 2020.

The meeting was therefore opened by the Chairman in his home on the due date and immediately closed due to a Quorum not being present in line with the Club's Constitution. No Comments had however been received by the Secretary prior to the due date of the Meeting concerning any errors, inaccuracies or points for discussion in the issued documents.

FOR HISTORICAL PURPOSES THE REASONING IS NOW INCLUDED.


Following the Covid-19 Pandemic in 2020-21 the 2020 AGM was not able to be held due to Government imposed restrictions. This prevented more than 6 people meeting (Rule of 6). Following is the Government requirements on the population as enforced from November 5th 2020.

“Prime Minister Boris Johnson announced that England would go into a second ‘lockdown’ from 5 November 2020. The aim of the lockdown is to reduce transmission of Covid-19. In a televised statement [the Prime Minister said that from 5 November 2020, people in England would be asked to stay at home](#) and only go out for the following reasons:

- education;
- work, if this cannot be done from home;
- exercise and recreation outdoors;
- medical reasons;
- appointments;
- escaping injury or harm;
- shopping for food and essentials;
- providing care for vulnerable people; or
- volunteering.

Non-essential shops, leisure and entertainment venues will be required to close. Pubs, bars and restaurants will be allowed to operate takeaway and delivery services only. Further [detailed guidance on the new measures](#) is available on the government website.
